<sup>42</sup>And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the <u>fellowship</u>, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

### Acts 2:43

<sup>43</sup>And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.

## Acts 2:44-45

<sup>44</sup>And all who believed were together and had all things in common. <sup>45</sup>And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need.

### Acts 2:46-47

<sup>46</sup>And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

<sup>14</sup>Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what <u>fellowship</u> has light with darkness?

<sup>15</sup>What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what portion does a believer share with an unbeliever?

# Philippians 2:3-4

<sup>3</sup>Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. <sup>4</sup>Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.

- 2. κοινωνία is voluntarily sharing life together for a common purpose of glorifying Jesus Christ.
- 3. κοινωνία is made possible by the Holy Spirit so it only exists between believers.

# Κοινωνία (Fellowship)

4. We prosper spiritually when we are dedicated to genuine fellowship like the early church.

- a) The Word of God
- b) κοινωνία (Biblical Fellowship)
- c) The Breaking of Bread
  - Eating together in a generous and thankful way that remembers Jesus, including the Lord's Supper
- d) Prayer
